ISLA DEPLOYMENT ROLES & DUTIES

Diplomat – Administrator working as liaison to enhance future operations. Performs the Media Specialist duties on the deployment.

Operation Commander – Team leader in charge of all aspects of the deployed operation, formerly called Project Leader. ISLA rank must be "Squad Leader" or above for non-Academy projects; "Watch Commander" for ISLA teams larger than 6 volunteers. The ISLA Operation Commander MUST have the rank of Marine Safety Officer to lead a operation with a training Academy.

Head Instructor – Lead Instructor in charge of all aspects of the operations training academy. Performs the Beach Accountability Supervisor duties on all physical events.

Co-Head Instructor – (If applicable) One of two Instructors in charge of all aspects of the operations training academy. One Co-Head Instructor performs the Beach Safety Specialist duties, while the other performs the Water Safety Supervisor duties on all physical events

Media Specialist – Lifeguard/Instructor in charge of documenting and sharing the operation online.

Beach Accountability Supervisor - In charge of starting the physical event, documenting results of the physical events, initiating the team's emergency response plan, babysitting the "DNFs" until there are enough to warrant a "Lead Safeguard Instructor."

Water Safety Supervisor – Instructor in charge of setting up and conducting physical events. Uses a rescue board to insure proper spacing of instructors during cadet swims.

Lead Safeguard Instructor – Instructor in charge of training and curriculum for noncertifiable lifeguard cadets. Wears a unique green and blue beanie and is tasked with the "turtle position" during all cadet physical event swims.

Drill Instructor – Instructor tasked with the discipline and the public's perception of the academy. Leads group stretches and exercises while other instructors coordinate activities.

Classroom Specialist – Instructor tasked with cadet academy records and ensuring the classroom is functional, clean, and secure.

ISLA DEPLOYMENT ROLES & DUTIES

Assistant Safeguard Instructor – Instructor who assists the Lead Safeguard Instructor

Assistant Instructor – Academy instructor without a specific role in the deployed operation.

Lead Lifeguard – An assistant to the Operation Commander on non-training academy deployment. Leads a small detachment of ISLA lifeguards for a brief period.

Lifeguard – Lifeguard without a specific role on a non-training academy operation.

Administrative Aid – A ISLA volunteer that is not lifeguard certified that is given a specific administrative role while deployed.
